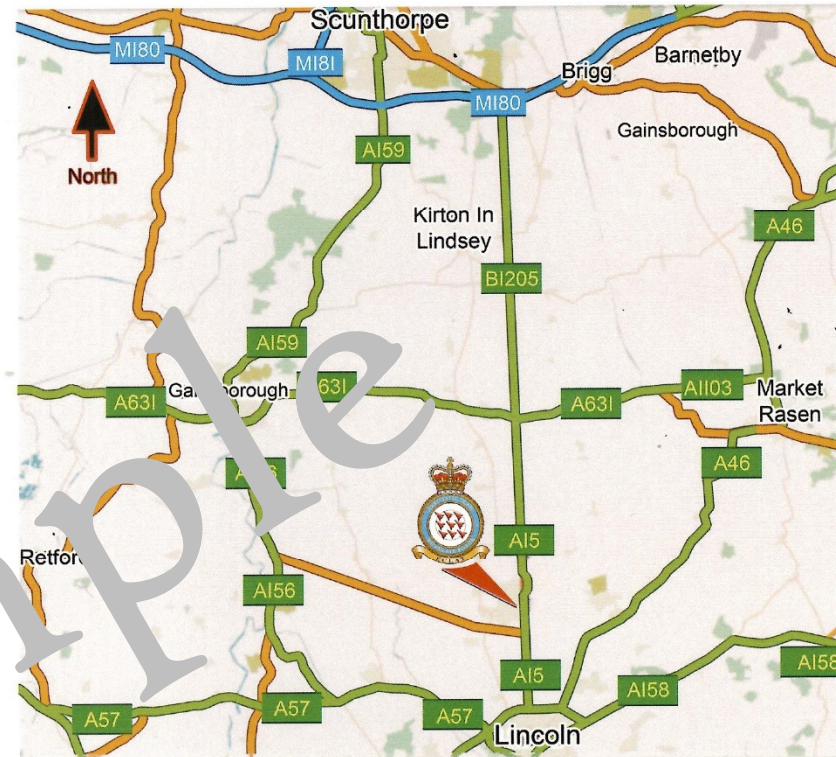

HOW TO FIND US



Travelling from the M180 – Exit the M180 at Junction 4 and travel south on the A15 towards Lincoln. RAF Scampton is signposted off the A15 approximately 4 miles North of Lincoln.

Travelling from Lincoln – Head north on the A15 towards the M180/Humber Bridge. RAF Scampton is sign posted off the A15. We are approximately 4 miles from the centre of Lincoln.

If you have satellite navigation systems our postcode is LN1 2ST. This can sometimes direct people onto Polyplatt Lane, do not take this exit off the A15 as this will lead you round the outside of the camp. If travelling from the M180 the entrance to the camp will be before the Polyplatt Lane turning. If travelling from Lincoln the entrance to the camp will be the next one after the Polyplatt Lane turning.

On Arrival at RAF Scampton you will need to park in the Main Guardroom (MGR) car park and report to the MGR Staff. A Red Arrows Representative will meet you and escort you to the Red Arrows Squadron.
