**Remembrance Service – 11<sup>th</sup> November 10.40am**

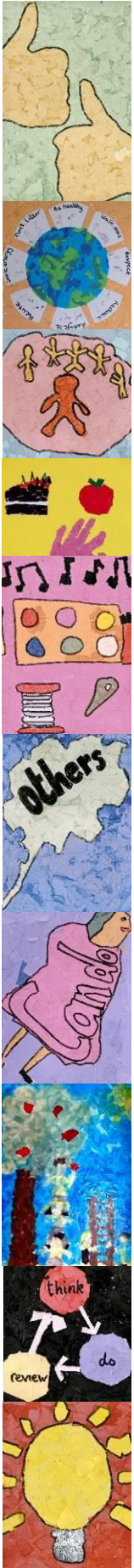
