

Car Park:

Firstly, a massive thank you to everyone who is using the car park correctly. We really appreciate how some parents and grandparents are using the car park as it is intended - they are parking so that one car is in each space and driving slowly around.

Sadly we've had some problems with the car park again since the beginning of term. Unfortunately we have a minority who we would like to think don't know the rules of the car park so we have outlined them below:

1. Please park so your car only takes one space and doesn't go over the lines;
2. Please ensure your car doesn't stop everyone walking around the edge of the car park or across the zebra crossing;
3. If you have a blue badge, please park in the disabled space provided;
4. If there are no clear spaces, please park near the path by the green gate or down School Lane;
5. Please don't stop anywhere - find a space and walk to the gate;
6. Treat other car park users as we would like to be treated.

We would like help to ensure everyone follows the rules. Please make anyone who is going to pick up a child aware of how to use the car park. If you see anyone not using the car park correctly, please take a picture of their car not being parked correctly and send it to enquiries@pollyplatt.lincs.sch.uk. We will then contact that driver and issue them with a warning. If they continue to not use the car park by the rules then we will ban that car and person from the car park. If we're unsure whose car it is then we will publish the photograph in the next newsletter to find out who the owner is.
